

Lutheranhands Youth Mission Trip:

to the Sandy Valley Region of Kentucky **July 13 - July 19.**We will be staying at the Foley Mission Center:

- 18,000 square-foot facility in Martin County, Kentucky that houses up to 120 volunteers as they work to repair homes in Appalachia
- All meals, bunk rooms, and bathrooms with showers will be at this one location
- Participants need to bring sheets and a pillow
- Our Work Partner, Christian Appalachian Project (CAP) was founded more than 60 years ago and has grown to touch the lives of more than 1 million people each year.

The cost is \$250 per person (plus money for extra food and souvenirs)

- \$100 due by Sunday, March 30
- \$150 due by Sunday, May 18

The rest of the cost (\$275) will be covered by the church. There will be 1-2 fundraisers. 100% participation.
